<u>REPORT ON THE STATUS OF THE RHODOPEAN LILY</u> (*Lilium rhodopaeum*) in the locality near village of Stoykite, <u>Smolyan district, Bulgaria – 2022</u>

The locality of the Rhodopean lily was visited twice this year (26.06.22 and 13.08.22).

Total number of the population is 613 individuals, 356 of them flowering and 257 vegetative. This is the highest number of the individuals in the population since counts began! Of the flowering individuals, there were 255 with a single bloom, 76 with 2 blooms, and 25 with 3 blooms in their inflorescence.

Ratio of the flowering/vegetative individuals is 1,39 (356F/257V) in favour of flowering ones.

The trend of increasing of the total population number continues this year too – up about 72%, compared with 2021.

Insects have damaged five of all individuals.

Among 2022, there were no impact of grazing in the population of the Rhodopean lily until the end of flowering season.

Due to the lack of grazing, we found an increase of bracken - *Pteridium aqulinum* and false helleborine - *Veratrum album*.

In several places in the locality, areas excavated by wild boars were observed.

This year Rhodope lilies failed to form fruit capsules.
