# WEATHER

The Winter was again very wet. Early April was cold with heavy rain on the 5th, and in the west it was windy and cold until 11th. The weather changed briefly from 12th-14th when it was hot and sunny, then there were a mixture of days which were overcast, hot sun and wind. May was cloudy up to 11th and then it was hot and sunny 12th-17th. The season settled then into the more regular pattern of a hot dry period until the Autumn rains.

#### RECORDS

This year has produced a range of surprises. The biggest of which was a flock of Mute Swans which arrived in Heraklion in northerly gales in January and even starred on Kriti TV. Other highlights were a White-tailed Lapwing(Plover) which spent the day at Elounda Saltpans after heavy rain and storms on 5th April.

Interesting records included a female Red-breasted Merganser, an Egyptian Vulture, Golden Plover, Whimbrel, Great Spotted Cuckoo, Savi's Warbler, Aquatic Warbler, Semi-collared Flycatcher, Coal tit, an all too fleeting glimpse of a possible Wallcreeper, and a Common Rosefinch.
