The Sologne itself boasts some 1200 plant species for the botanist to get to grips with, and over 280 species of bird have been recorded amongst the 2000 lakes of the Brenne. With 110 species of butterfly and 62 varieties of dragonfly, the Loire is a draw for wildlife enthusiasts of all kinds and this new guide helps you maximise your time in the region.
