


The need for a model of sustainable farming

A Network of Agronatural farms in Menorca A voluntary commitment






A NETWORK OF AGRONATURAL FARMS

In 2016, there was a network of 27 farms with 2000 hectares of private conservation





Conserve nature

Water, fertile land and species that require active management for preservation and prevention of extinction.











Maintain and improve the countryside

Improve the visual impact of access roads, farm installations and main areas.









Sow local agricultural varieties

Regeneration of local agricultural varieties which are environmentally compatible giving distinctive local produce.









Maintain and develop suitable breeds

Regeneration of indigenous and adapted breeds which are environmentally compatible giving distinctive local produce.











Maintain and restore the ethnological heritage

Restoration of ethnologically important sites (kilns, winnowing grounds, wells, water cisterns, etc)

Sponsor education and training

Identify the strong points of the farm or of its management to use as examples (management of water, commmercialitzations, local varieties, fertilisers, energy, etc).







Identify potential for leisure use

Points of interest, routes, countryside, animals, archaeology, events, etc, which can be attractive for excursions.







Identify potential for tourism

Identify attractions for tourist visits.









Identify tasks which can be done by volunteers

Essential maintenance which can be done with the help of volunteers.









Identify essential resources and optimize them

Machinery and essential equipment for communal use or for possible exchange.









Identify economic potential

Possibilities for making different products for marketing and increasing tourist outlets.
